# **Quarterly Report for January – March 2007**

#### I. Overview

The mission of the School Construction Bond Citizens' Oversight Committee (BOC) is to oversee the expenditure of money for the construction, repair and modernization of schools by the LAUSD and to communicate its findings to the Board and the public so that school bond funds are invested as the voters intended and that projects are completed wisely and efficiently.

The shared vision between the BOC and the LAUSD is to build and maintain schools that promote the full development of the child, are educationally and environmentally sound, enhance their neighborhoods through design and programming as centers of community, and reflect the wise and efficient use of limited land and public resources.

The BOC presents this Quarterly Report as the discharge of its duties. This Report covers activities of the BOC during the 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter of Calendar Year 2007 (January--March).

#### V. Joint Board Activities

- Funding (\$3,000,000) for a Joint-Use Project at Glassell Park Early Education Center was approved by the BOC. The partner for this project is the Los Angeles Community Design Center (LACDC). The LADC will provide a matching contribution of \$3,000,000 in resources, i.e., capital, programming, maintenance and operational support. The project consists of approximately 45 units of affordable apartments, a seven classroom early education center, and an underground parking structure.
- Funding (\$6,030,000) for a Joint-Use Project at Central Los Angeles Area New Middle School No. 1 (\$1,500,000); Central Los Angeles Area New High School No. 2 (\$2,440,000); and, Valley Region High School No. 5 (\$2,090,000) was approved by the BOC. The partner for Central Los Angeles Area New Middle School No. 1 is the American Youth Soccer Organization (AYSO). The programmatic contribution from AYSO will be \$1,690,000 over five years. The scope of work will include installation of synthetic turf material to provide for year-round play. The partner for Central Los Angeles Area New High School No. 2 is the Los Angeles Department of Recreation and Parks. The programmatic contribution from the Los Angeles Department of Recreation and Parks is \$2,225,698 over ten years. The scope of work includes installation of synthetic turf on the main field; spectator bleachers (home and visitor); scoreboard; restroom, staff office and concession facility; and, public address system. The partner for Valley Region High School No. 5 is the City of San Fernando. The programmatic contribution from the City of San Fernando is \$2,090,400 over 10 years. The scope of work includes installation of synthetic turf on the main field; additional exterior field and outdoor court lighting; and, additional telescoping seating in the multi-purpose room.

#### VI. Task Force Activities

#### VII. Overall Trends Noted

- Construction cost escalation continues to be a challenge.
- Environmental evaluation costs are a challenge.
- Legislation to change the way the state calculates eligibility continues to be pursued.
- Increasing remediation costs are putting pressure on project budgets.

#### IV. New Construction

- The Charter community has been engaged in revising the charter school expansion policy.
- The Vista Hermosa site is 47% complete and is scheduled to open in 2008.
- Central Los Angeles HS No. 1 is behind schedule. The project is under intensive management review. Completion is expected in 2008.
- The amount of green space is increased with each new school. Over 4,000 new trees have been planted and 300 acres of open space added.
- LAUSD and DSA are partnering to ensure there is appropriate review staff available for LAUSD projects.

#### V. Modernization

- The Capital Improvement Program includes 19,263 projects valued at \$4.1 billion.
- There are 4,814 projects either in pre-construction or construction.
- LAUSD has been able to leverage bond projects for a total of \$934 million.

# VI. Committee Member—Appointments/Resignations/Elections

BOC member, John Hakel, representing the Associated General Contractors of California, resigned from the BOC. The BOC is in the process of filling this position. The BOC welcomed new BOC member, Virginia Tanzmann, representing the American Institute of Architects – Los Angeles Chapter. There are currently two vacancies on the BOC, a representative from the California Taxpayers' Association and a representative from an Environmental Justice/Civil Rights Group.

# VII. LAUSD Facilities Services Division—Status of New Construction and Modernization of Existing Facilities Projects

As reported by the LAUSD Facilities Services Division, the current status of New Construction and Modernization of existing Facilities Projects are set forth in the attached monthly status reports. The monthly status report for New Construction (Exhibit 2) is the report provided to the BOC by the LAUSD Facilities Services Division at the BOC's March 21, 2007 meeting and reflects the status as of March 15, 2007. The monthly status report for Existing Facilities (Exhibit 3) is the report provided to the BOC by the LAUSD Facilities Services Division at the BOC's March 21, 2007 meeting and reflects the status as of March 1, 2007.

### VIII. BOC Budget

The BOC's Annual Budget for the July 1, 2006-June 30, 2007 Fiscal Year is \$670,054.00 Actual expenditures through March 2007 were \$317,367.55 or 47% of the budget.


# NEW CONSTRUCTION K-12 PROGRAM STATUS REPORTS 236 Projects









#### **GENERAL**

The District is pursuing initiatives to change State law to ensure educational facilities are provided equally to all students throughout the State. The proposed bills would provide much needed State funding to help finish our massive voter approved, bond funded, school construction and modernization program. Current eligibility legislation will not help fund a seat for a student if there is a single open seat available in the district. For example, if a student needs a seat downtown and there is an open seat in Sylmar (not a neighborhood school for the student) the State will not provide matching funds. If the State Formula is not fixed, we may not achieve our goal of providing a 2-semester, neighborhood school for every LAUSD student. Ultimately, we hope the change in legislation will benefit all urban Districts and we are working diligently to collaborate with them on this.

Superintendent Brewer testified during the Committee Hearing on SB 121 this month and District Officials will continue to support this important legislation at upcoming Hearings on the other LAUSD sponsored bills. AB 1014, the bill sponsored by Majority Leader Karen Bass is scheduled for April 17th in Sacramento.

According to the Los Angeles Downtown News, this award goes to projects in the city of Los Angeles that affects "more than just its borders" and that have "...made its neighborhood, and by extension all of Downtown, a better place for those who live, work and visit ..."

#### **Discovering the Arts- Central LA High School #9**

The next Discovering the Arts Board Meeting is scheduled for March 28th. Participants will discuss the hiring of an Executive Director, the organizational structure of the high school, and New Construction will provide a project update.

#### **Project Activities**

- Preferred sites:
  - 44 out of 48 Phase II/III projects requiring land acquisition have Board-designated preferred sites. The 4 projects without preferred sites include:
    - Central Region Span 6-12 #1
    - South Region HS #8
    - South Region MS #7
    - Valley Region Span K-8 #1
  - 17 Phase IV projects require Board designation of preferred sites. Site selection community meetings for Phase IV began in February 2007.
- 31 Phase II/III projects have Board authorization to make offers and enter into purchase agreements. Currently, nearly 500 offers have been presented to purchase these properties.
- In the last year:
  - o 243 properties have closed escrow and 6 additional properties have open escrows.
  - o 1.052 households and businesses have been relocated.

#### REAL ESTATE DEPARTMENT

#### **Program Activities**

- The Real Estate Department is working in close collaboration with other departments, on an expedited basis, to maximize dwindling opportunities to obtain state matching funds.
- South Region HS #13 is being presented to the Board on April 24th for redesignation of preferred site. The first site failed environmental due diligence because the health risk assessment indicated that pollution levels from multiple industrial and transportation sources rendered the site infeasible for a school.

#### SCHOOL PLANNING & DESIGN DEPARTMENT

#### **Current Design Activities**

- Three projects were approved by the DSA in March, 2007. The projects are VREEC# 1, SRES# 1 and SRMS# 6
- DSA provided two training sessions on March 29: DSA 101 focused on Pre-construction activities and DSA 201 focused on activities during construction. LAUSD staff along with architectural and engineering consultants attended the presentation.
- 21 projects are currently under review at the DSA.
- A total of 11 Phase II projects have been approved.

#### **Charter School Facilities**

Representatives from the Facilities Services Division, the Charter School Division and Bond Oversight Committee staff have been meeting regularly with the charter school community to establish a model for the use of the remaining charter bond dollars. The goal is to meet the intent of the bond measures and the needs of LAUSD and charter schools by providing the charter community with facilities of quality in the most efficient, effective and timely manner possible.

New Construction will propose a charter facilities policy to the Board in April 2007.

#### CONSTRUCTION DEPARTMENT

#### **Construction Economics**

- The average price for Portland cement started March with a 1.8% increase, capping seven months of constant hikes. This month's increase pushed prices 7.6% above a year ago.
- Prices for copper water tubing fell 2% this month, but they are still 33% above a year ago. Prices for corrugated steel pipe also fell this month but remain 12% above 2007 level.

#### Central Los Angeles Area New High School #1 (Helen Bernstein HS)

- This project has been beset with problems including issues with the design; unexpected weather delays; unsatisfactory contractor planning, supervision and quality control; and insufficient subcontractor staffing. The construction is now 84% complete, and scheduled for occupancy in September 2008.
- The contractor has recently replaced its project leadership at both the field and executive levels and in addition they have added supervisory and engineering staff. As a consequence, production and quality have markedly improved.
- The project is under intensive management by both the District and the Contractor, with weekly executive issue resolution meetings to ensure satisfactory project progress without delay.

#### Central Los Angeles Area New High School # 9 (450 North Grand)

- Major foundation and structural work continues. The structural steel frames for the Library, Music and Art Buildings are complete; exterior framing is in varying stages of completion; and interior framing is underway, as are all utility systems.
  - The structural steel framing for the Theater Building is well underway, with the iconic tower taking shape. The reinforced concrete Parking Structure is approximately 50% complete.

#### Central Los Angeles Area New High School #11 (Vista Hermosa)

- Construction on the park continues. Major earthwork is complete and the installation of underground utilities and retaining walls is underway. Construction of the methane mitigation system has commenced.
- The project is 53% complete and on schedule for a substantial completion early in 2008.

#### CONSTRUCTION DEPARTMENT

#### Central Los Angeles Area New Learning Center #1 (Ambassador Site)

- K-3 17406 Proposal Packages were received from three contractors on March 22, 2007, and are under evaluation. Contract award is anticipated in May 2007.
- The 4-12 school construction design was submitted to DSA on January 30, 2007. DSA review is proceeding on schedule, with DSA approval anticipated in late September 2007.
- The Draft SEIR for the modifications to the structure of the Cocoanut Grove is now under in-house review. It
  is anticipated to be released for public comment in late April, with the public comment period closing in late
  May and submittal to the Board for approval in the summer of 2007.


























#### **CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM**

(\$4.2 Billion Funded Project Value - 19,327 Projects)








**Project Count** (Bond Program)
