# Julia Morgan

---

- In 1919 William Randolph Hearst hired Julia Morgan to design a main building and guest houses for his ranch in San Simeon, California.
- Julia Morgan was California's first female architect. In 1894, she was the first woman to graduate with a Degree in Civil Engineering. With a legacy of over 700 buildings to her credit, it's no wonder she was also the first woman to be granted the L'Ecole des Beaux Arts Certificate (1902) in Paris, France.

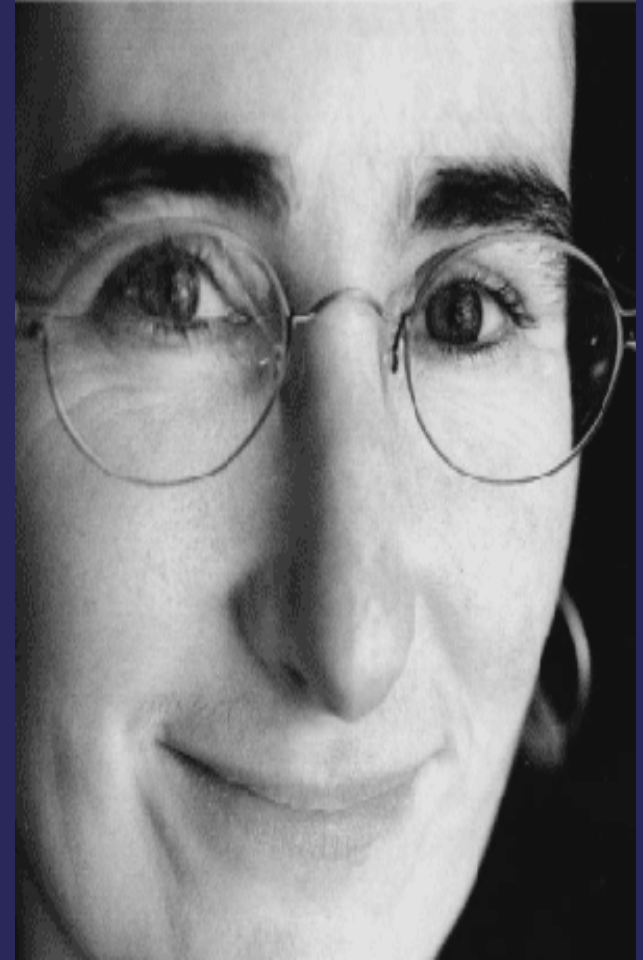

# Julia Barfield

---

- The London Eye was created by Julia Barfield and David Marks 1999-2000
- The thirty-two passenger capsules are totally enclosed and, unlike the ferris wheel, are motorized and on the outside of the wheel. One revolution takes about thirty minutes.
- This observation wheel, which hangs out over the Thames, was designed to celebrate the Millennium. The largest in the world, it is one of London's top tourist attractions

# Zaha Hadid

---

- The first woman to win the Pritzker Prize for Architecture in its 26 year history, ZAHA HADID (1950-) has defined a radically new approach to architecture by creating buildings, such as the Rosenthal Center for Contemporary Art in Cincinnati, with multiple perspective points and fragmented geometry to evoke the chaos of modern life
